



#### Prison population over the last 50 years






35,009 Prisoners












#### Sentenced prison population: 4 years and over (excluding indeterminates)

The offence make-up of the prison population is changing; towards offences that carry longer sentences.




In 1993, Violence Against the Person (VATP), Sexual Offences and Drug Offences together accounted for around **two** in every **five** sentenced prisoners (including the recall population).

By 2016, this had increased to three in five.

**7,321** lifers **3,998** on Indeterminate Public Protection sentences.

#### **Recalled to prison**



In June 1995 only **150** people were recalled

# The population is projected to remain stable to June 2019, but then to increase to 1,600 places above the current level in March 2022.

The most recent estimates reflect increases in custody rates and sentence lengths for indictable offences, as well as growth in the remand population, which offset a decline in the number of offenders sentenced.
